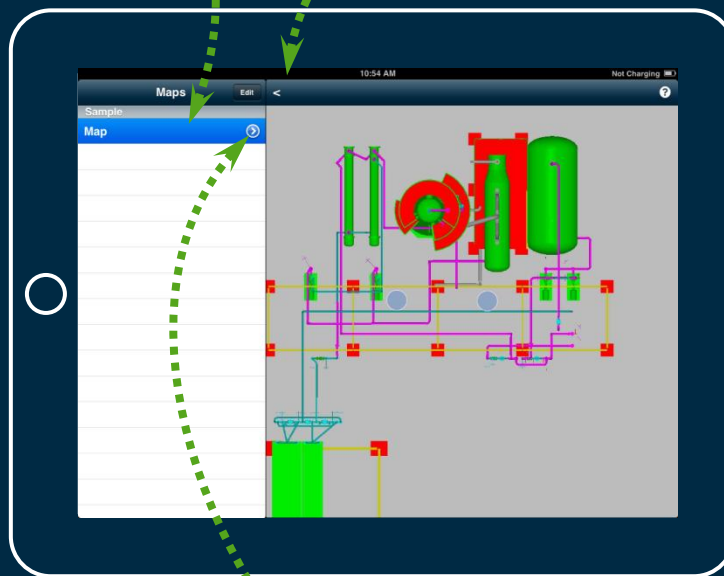


Viewing Optimized i-models

When you open Bentley Navigator for the iPad you see a list of maps containing points of interest.

Tap a **map name** to display the map.

Tap the **hide arrow** to hide the list.



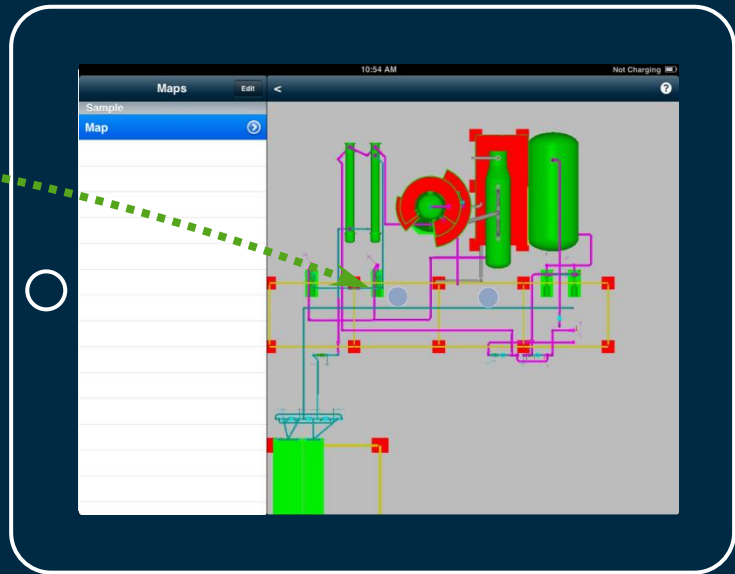
Tap the **arrow** next to the map name to see a list of points of interest on the map.



Opening Points of Interest

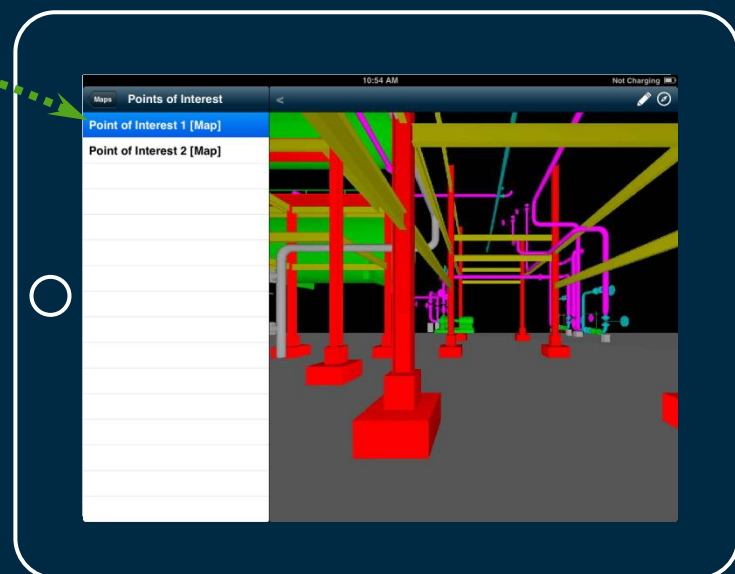
There are two ways to navigate to points of interest on a map.

Tap a
point of interest
on a map.



OR

Tap a
point of interest
in the list.



Rotating the View

You can rotate the view by using touch gestures or by using the motion sensors in the iPad.



Tap the **Motion Sensor** button to enable motion-sensitive viewing. Tap it again to disable it.



Drag your finger in the direction you want to rotate.

OR

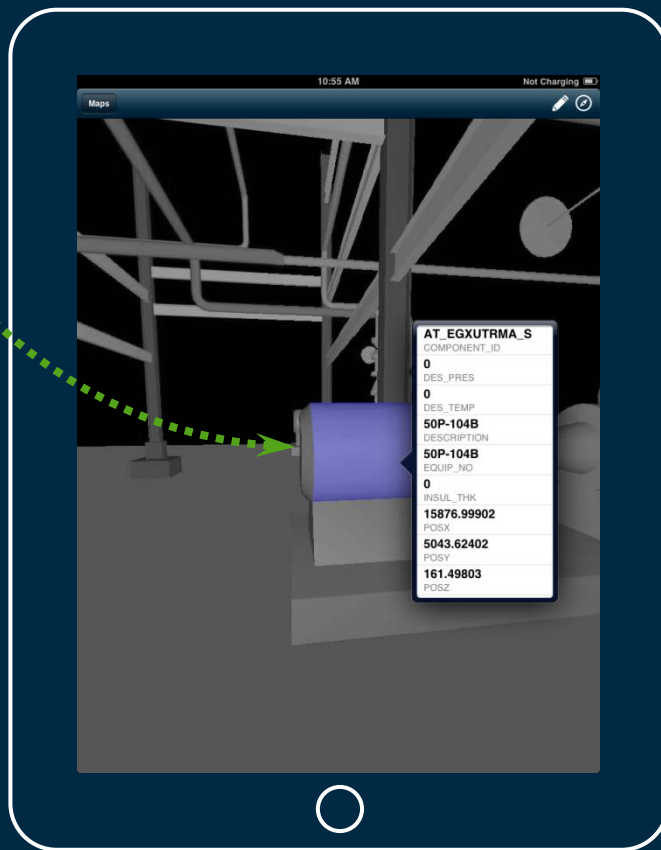


Tilt and rotate the iPad.




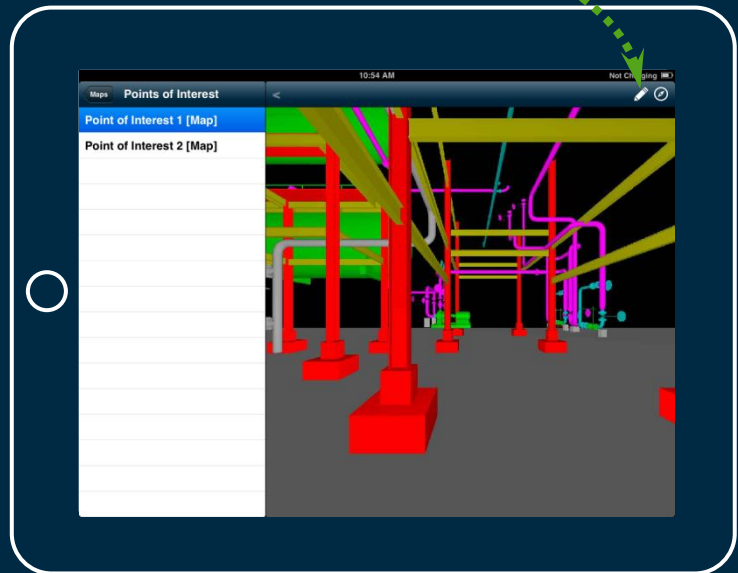
Viewing Object Properties

Tap and hold an object to display its properties.

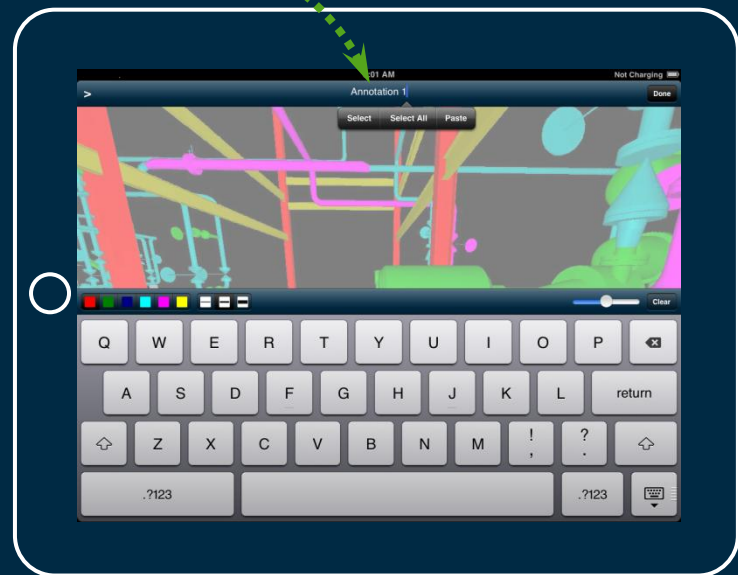


Creating Annotations

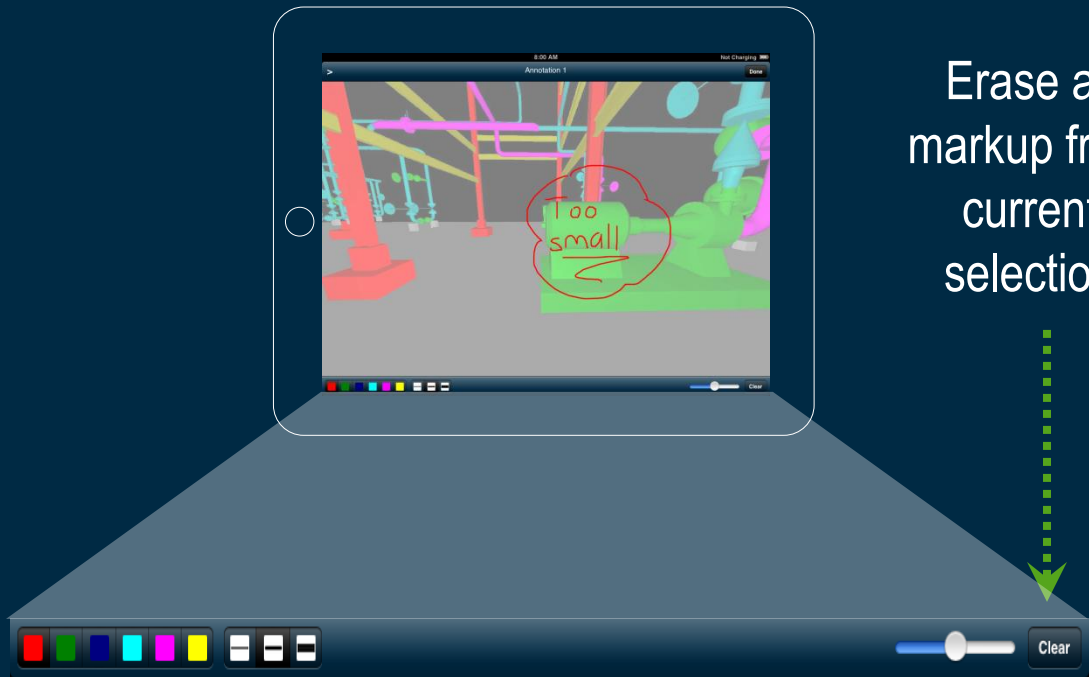
Tap the **pencil**  button to create an overlay on which you can make annotations.



Tap the **annotation name** to rename it. Tap and hold the name for editing options (Select/Select All, Copy/Paste).

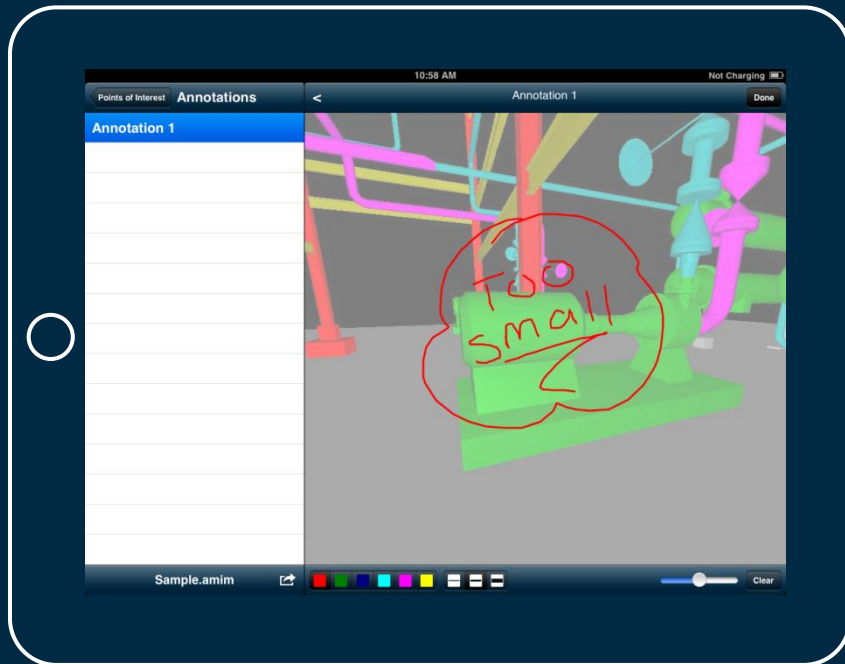

Annotations List

To see a list of working annotations, tap the **pencil** button. The list appears on the left.

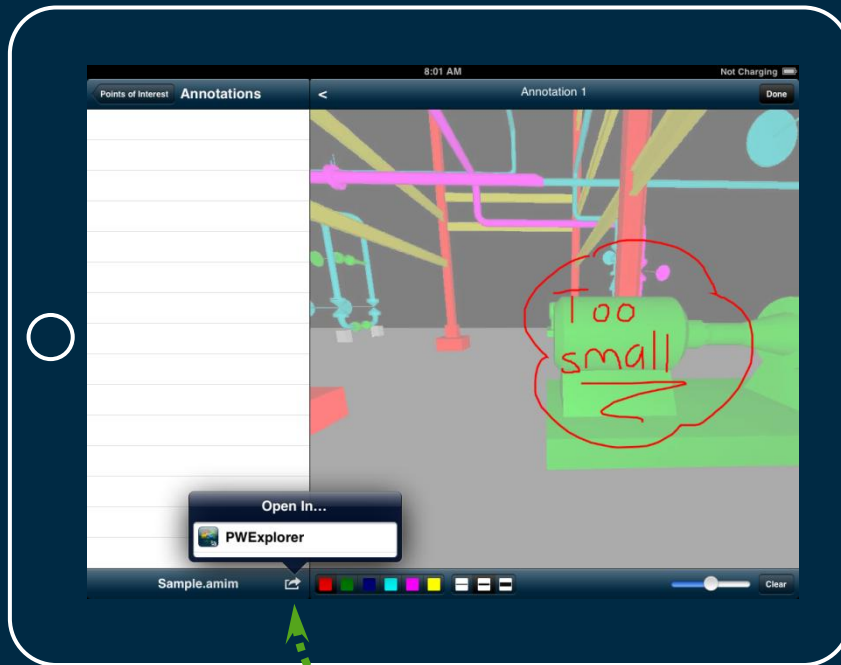


Tap an annotation in the list to view it or add more mark up to it.



Saving Annotations to ProjectWise

Tap the **action** button to save the annotations to ProjectWise Explorer for the iPad to be packaged.

Returning to the Home Page

Tap the **back** button (upper left button on any page) to return to the previous page.

If you need to return to the home page:



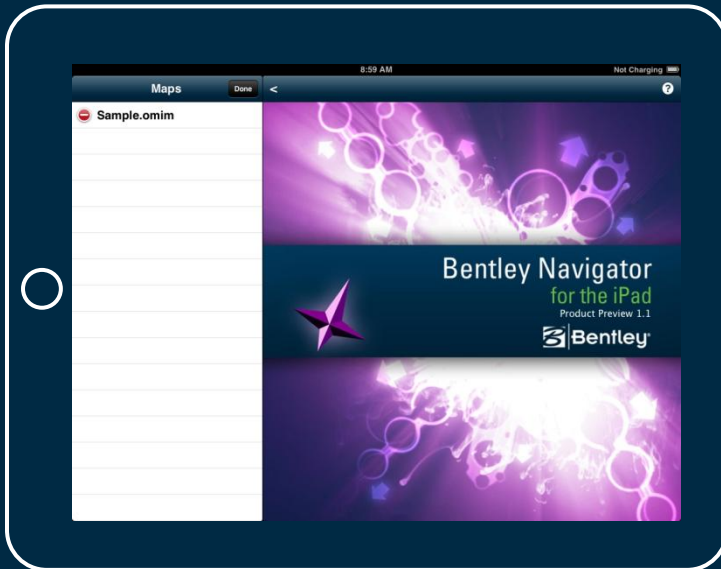
1. From Annotations, tap **Points of Interest**.



2. From Points of Interest, tap **Maps**.



3. From Maps, tap **Edit**.



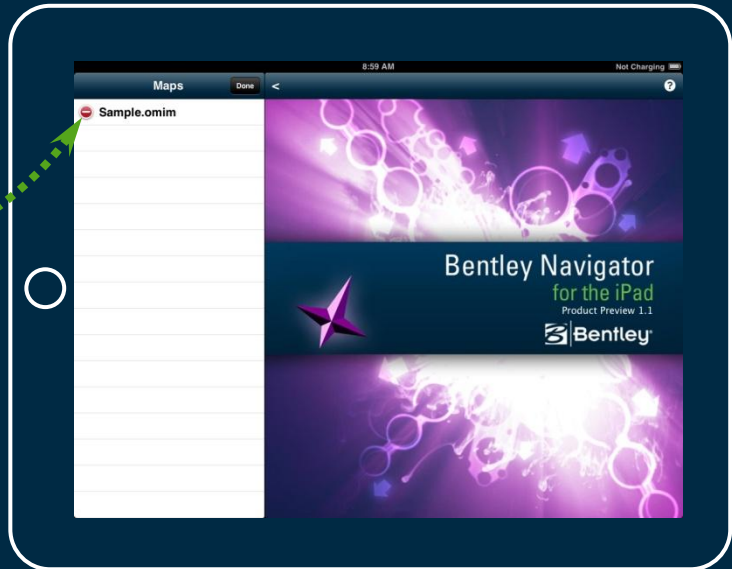
Now you are back at the home page.



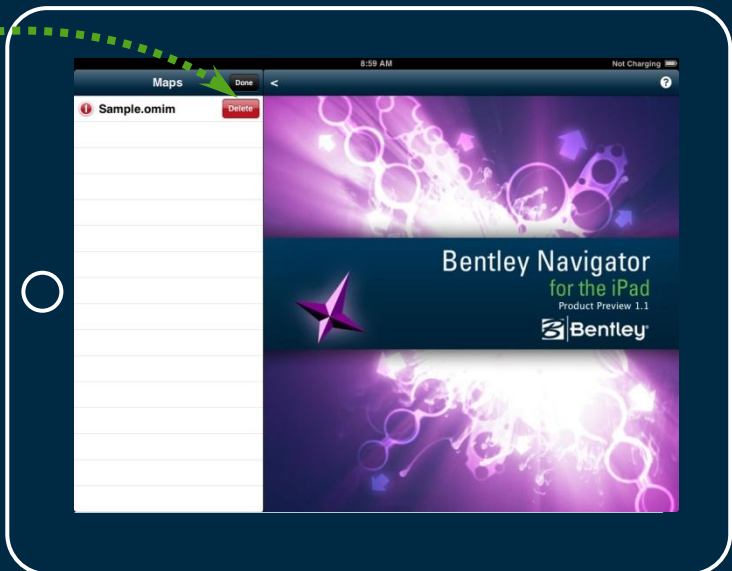
Deleting Optimized i-models

From the home page you can delete optimized i-models from the app.

1. Tap the **Edit** button. Then tap the **minus** button next to the OMIM file.



2. Tap the **Delete** button. Then tap **Done**.
